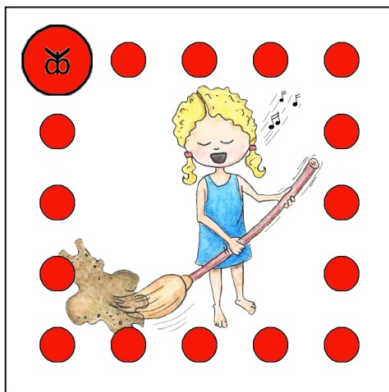

Object of the game: turn around upside down all your cards

Material: 1 set of cards for each player +
 1 set of cards for the caller

Preparation: Depending on your training goal, 6 or 8 cards are chosen out of the set. (For the four year olds. Older players can easily have more cards than that.) Each player and the caller have identic cards.

Each player has his own 6 or 8 cards face up before him on the table. He chooses one half of his cards for this turn, the other 3 or 4 cards are turned around and put away. So (normally) each player has different cards.

The caller shuffles all his cards (6 or 8) and puts them side by side face down on the table.

Playing mode: The caller takes one card, so that no one can see its face, and he describes it.

The player that discovers this very card amongst his own cards, shows it to the others, describes it and turns it back face down.

The caller puts away his first card. He takes and describes another one.

And so on until one player has returned all his cards.

That is the **end** of this turn.

The **winner** is the player who first has returned all his cards.
